

Mike has been a Volunteer Mediator since December 2020. Mike came to the program during the pandemic year, and attended basic training virtually. Mike first learned about Early Settlement Mediation through one of our volunteer mediators, the late Jay Scott Brown. Mike mostly volunteers in the Pottawatomie County area, but has assisted Seminole County from time to time.
