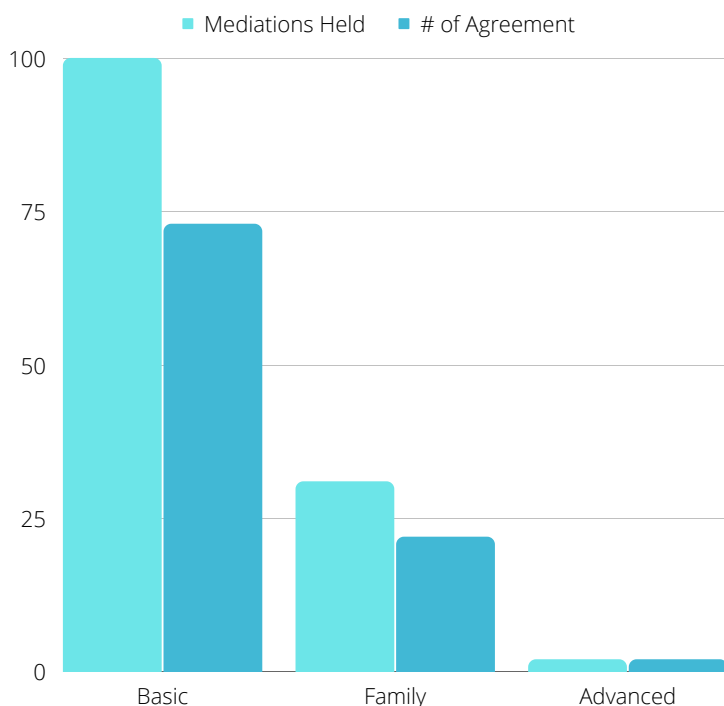
Volunteer Highlight: Greg Buckley
