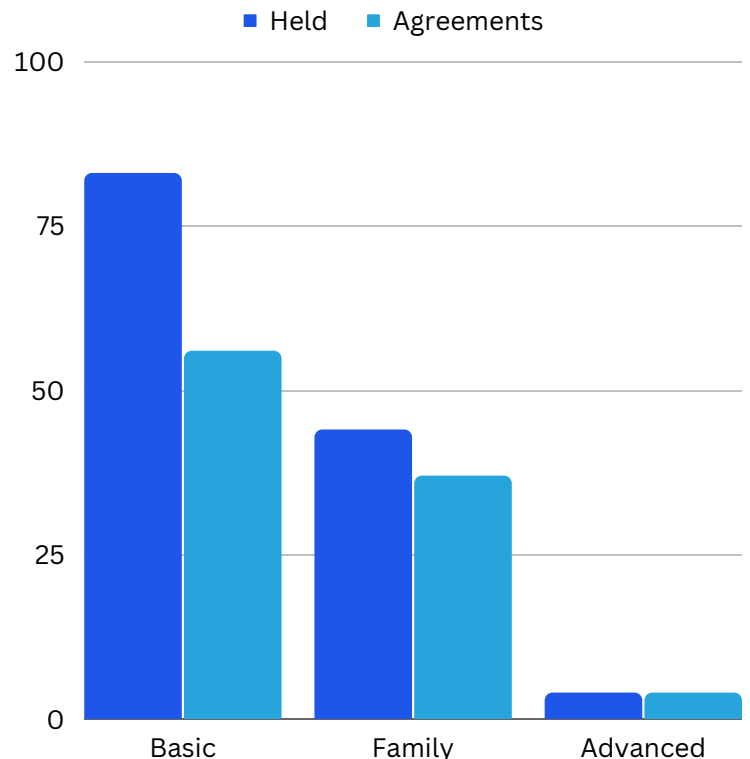
94 Referred
