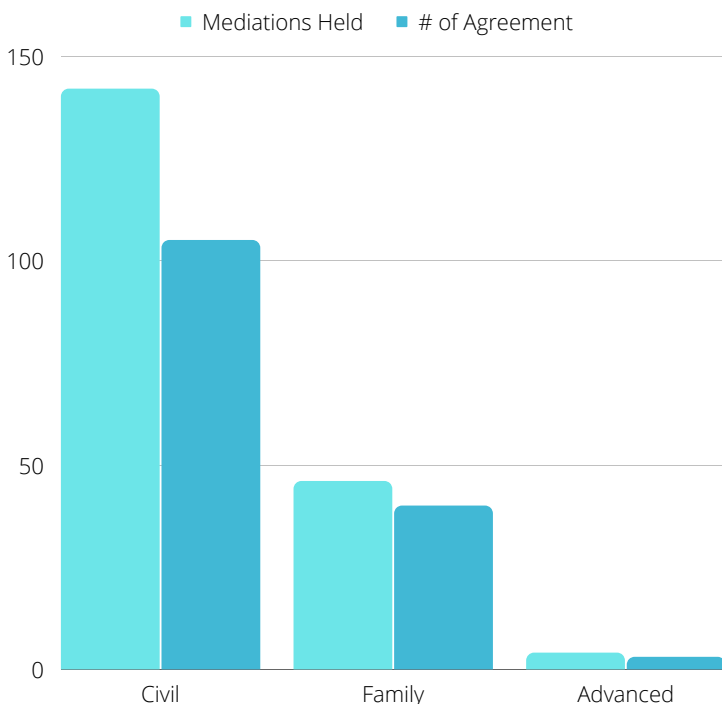
Volunteer Highlight: Glenn Meyer
