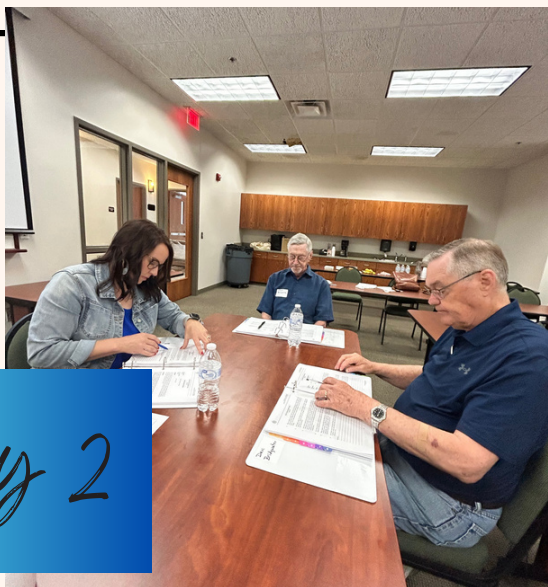

Volunteer Mediator of the Year, Tom Lackey, visited with the trainees about his experience as a certified mediator.

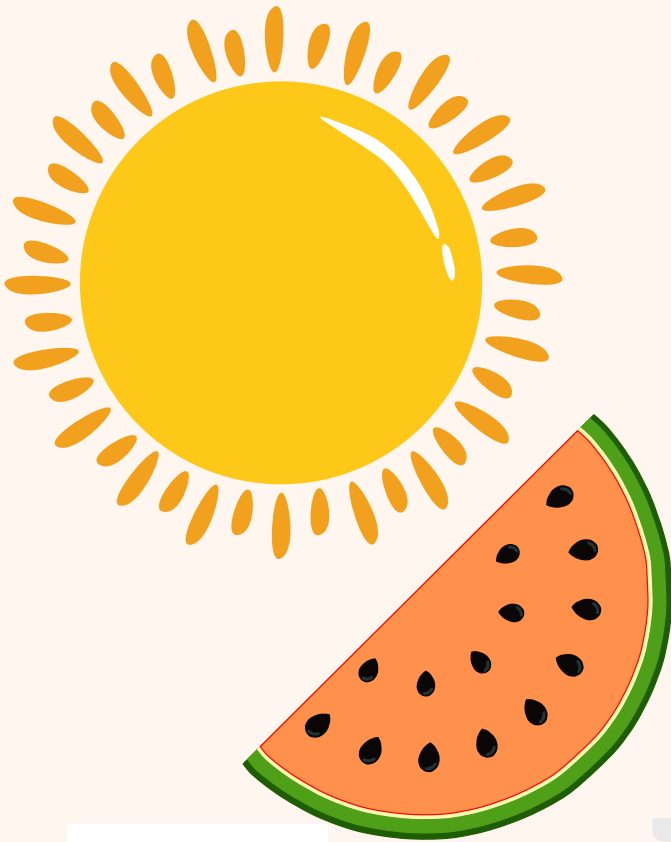
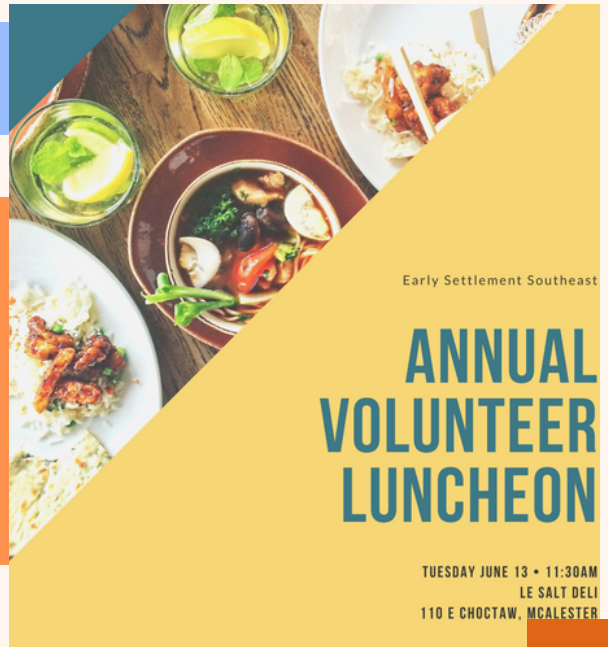

(69%)

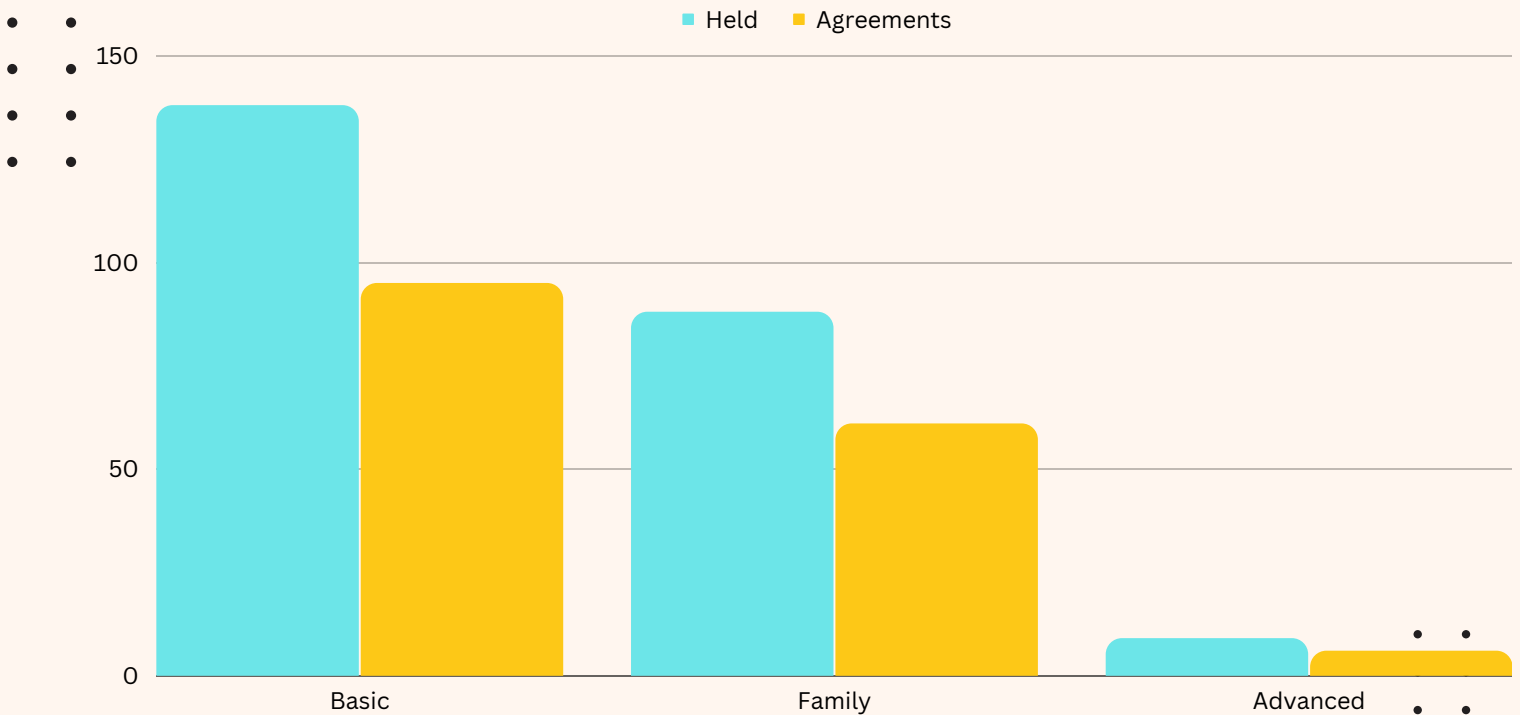
## FAMILY
