### Mediating Temporary Orders in Divorces

Mediation of temporary orders is often a very helpful process to attempt prior to a hearing that is likely to be ugly and create or worsen animosity between the parties.

Mediating temporary order agreements can set the tone for how the divorce can proceed and can encourage the parties to cooperate and negotiate during the extend of the divorce process. Mediation of temporary orders can also reduce any threat to civility, especially if there are children involved. Mediating temporary orders can create an opportunity for parents to explore different parenting arrangements on a trial basis to see what works best for their family before making any permanent changes.

Parties can voice request/needs without going overboard, can address timelines, and consider the possibilities for final settlement.






