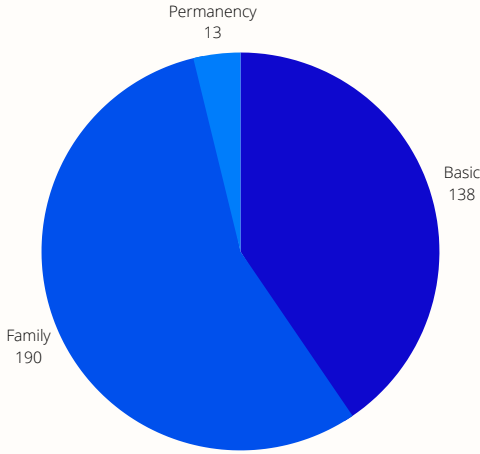
I have no idea what the next year will bring our way, but I am excited about all the things that the our program will do to help Southwest Oklahoma!

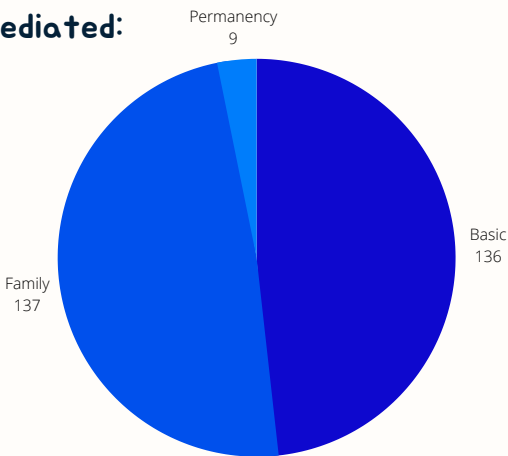
