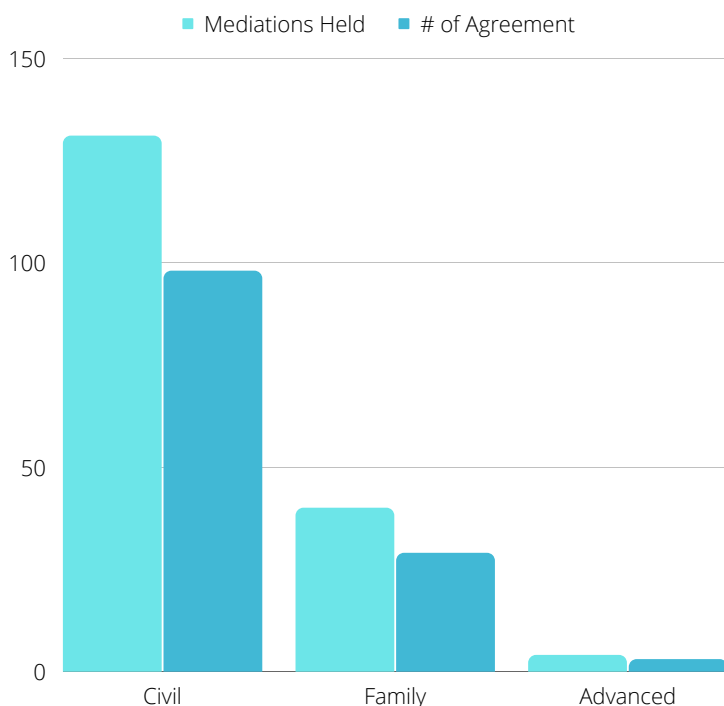
Volunteer Highlight: **Brenda Harrison**
